Explanations:

- (a) In the event of changes to the BRL and / or to (the composition of) the product and / or additions of product types, it is determined on the basis of the changes which standard requirements must be specifically reassessed.
- (b) Frequency at the start of certification is 6 visits per year. If audit results give cause for this, a reduction to a minimum of 4 visits is possible. The frequency can of course also be increased if audit results give cause for this.
- X1 Aspect must be assessed at least once a year. The assessor determines which audit visit (s) are appropriate.
