## Regulatory Alert — Customs Union

## Public consultation on amendments to Customs Union EMC and Safety Technical Regulations is currently ongoing

Eurasian Economic Commission has published proposal for amendments to Technical Regulations of Customs Union on "Electromagnetic compatibility of technical equipment" (TR TC 020/2011) and "On safety of low-voltage equipment" (TR CU 004/2011) on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2016. These are open for public consultation until 29<sup>th</sup> of July 2016.
